- FGDC Annual Reports
 - Discussion and input from Cadastral Producers
 - Dominica reviewed the status of the FGDC Annual reports. A draft has been provided to the currently identified data stewards. If you did not receive contact Dominica. The report is due to FGDC by March 19th and is due to the BLM for approvals by March 1st. The annual report updates progress on the data sets.

- The Mineral Land Records project (MLRS) is the BLM's current modernization project that will replace the LR2000 and the Alaska Records program. It is a three-year program that is about halfway through the development schedule. The mineral claims module has been completed and other modules will follow this year.
